

It is most often grown as a <u>leaf vegetable</u>. In many countries, it is typically eaten cold, raw, in <u>salads</u>

sandwiches

hamburgers

tacos

, and in many other dishes

The lettuce plant has a short stem initially (a <u>rosette</u> growth habit), but when it gradually blooms, the stem and branches lengthens; and produces many flower heads that look like those of <u>dandelions</u>, but smaller. This is referred to as <u>bolting</u>

. When grown to eat, lettuce is harvested before it bolts. Lettuce is used as a food plant by the

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Lettuce is a low $\underline{\text{calorie}}$ food and is a source of $\underline{\text{vitamin A}}$ and $\underline{\text{folic acid}}$.
