, as well as the basic

categories of being

and their relations.

Traditionally listed as a part of the major branch of philosophy known as metaphysics

, ontology often deals with questions concerning what

entities

exist or may be said to exist and how such entities may be grouped, related within a <u>hierarchy</u>

, and subdivided according to similarities and differences. Although ontology as a philosophical enterprise is highly hypothetical, it also has practical application in

information science

and

technology

, such as

ontology engineering

. A very simple definition of ontology is that it is the examination of what is meant, in context, by the word 'thing'.
